



NAPOLEONSBERG CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2019

The Napoleonsberg Cabernet Sauvignon is made in honour of the Simonsberg, located in the heart of the Cape Winelands. Napoleonsberg is the historical name for this mountain. Crafted only in the best vintages, this is a small batch wine which respects every terroir factor of its environment.

Terroir & Winemaking

Situated in the foothills of the 1400m high Simonsberg, our vineyards are sheltered from harsh factors to bring consistency from harvest to harvest.

These specific Cabernet Sauvignon vines total 4 ha, made up of different grape clones and planted in multiple ancient soil types to promote complexity.

The blocks are vinified separately and matured in French oak barrels for 18 months allowing the flavours to develop and mature into a truly exceptional wine.

Tasting Notes

A light violet fragrance permeates this wine, leading to succulent red and blue berried fruit.

The flavours are restrained and classically Cabernet Sauvignon, ripe blackcurrant red plums and hedgerow fruit. Plush and rewarding.
