Winemakers Notes

All the grapes for Anni Sauvignon Blanc is from our farm in Elgin Casey's Ridge. Nestled amidst rolling hills and cool, mist-kissed vineyards, Elgin is a picturesque wine-producing area in South Africa renowned for its unique cool climate, resulting in wines of exceptional elegance and vibrancy. Our goal with the Vrede en Lust Anni Sauvignon Blanc is to create a fresh and elegant style that shows the cool climate surroundings. This is done by harvesting the grapes at different times during the growing season.

The grapes are picked at optimal ripeness and the free run juice is fermented with different yeast strains in stainless steel tanks. The wine spent 4 months on the lees and the result is a unique cool climate expression of Sauvignon Blanc with an excellent nose and palate.

Tasting Notes

This Sauvignon Blanc has balanced aromas of pome fruit and citrus. The unique soils impart a desirable flintiness which lingers on the finish. Expect fresh and pure fruit flavours of pear, green apple and a hint of green herbs.
