Our winemaking process is a harmonious blend of traditional craftsmanship and modern winemaking techniques, resulting in wines with elegance, complexity, and unparalleled quality.

## In the vineyard &amp; cellar

The Sauvignon Blanc grapes come from our Casey's Ridge farm in Elgin. Nestled amongst rolling hills and cool, misty vineyards, Elgin is a scenic wine region in South Africa known for its distinct cool climate, which produces wines of remarkable elegance and vibrancy. With the Vrede en Lust Anni Sauvignon Blanc, our goal is to create a fresh and elegant style that reflects this cool climate terroir. We achieve this by harvesting the grapes at different stages throughout the growing season. The grapes are picked at optimal ripeness and fermented with various yeast strains in stainless steel tanks. The wine is aged on the lees for four months, resulting in a unique expression of cool climate Sauvignon Blanc with an outstanding aroma and palate.

This Sauvignon Blanc showcases a harmonious blend of Granny Smith apples and citrus aromas. The distinctive soils at Casey's Ridge in Elgin lend a pleasing flintiness that lingers on the finish. Expect fresh, vibrant flavours of pear, green apple, and a subtle hint of minerality.
