The Vrede en Lust Artisan Range is an exclusive range of carefully handcrafted wines, made in very small quantities exclusively for our Wine Club Members. For this range the winemakers are encouraged to experiment with different styles and winemaking techniques using small batches of site specific grapes. The labels are reproduced from Karlin's own handwritten versions of the labels. The first Shiraz crop from Elgin vineyards was harvested in 2010, which was a 5-barrel run under the Artisan range.

From the vineyard & cellar

Harvested in mid-February, our Pinot Gris grapes were carefully crushed and gently fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve their bright, fresh character. Following fermentation, the wine was aged on its fine lees for several months, adding depth, texture, and a hint of complexity before being bottled in September. Sourced from our cool-climate Elgin vineyards, this Pinot Grigio—also known as Pinot Gris—delights with its delicately fragrant nose, offering subtle floral notes and hints of citrus.

In the bottle

Inspired by its popularity in Italy, this elegant wine showcases the vibrant, crisp, and refreshing profile that makes it a timeless favorite. A light and crisp white wine showing aromas of apple and pear. The zestiness of this wine will lend to being enjoyed on its own as a fashionable summer drink or paired perfectly with a variety of dishes.
