The Vrede en Lust Artisan Range is an exclusive range of carefully handcrafted wines, made in very small quantities exclusively for our Wine Club Members. For this range the winemakers are encouraged to experiment with different styles and winemaking techniques using small batches of site specific grapes. The labels are reproduced from Karlin's own handwritten versions of the labels. The first Shiraz crop from Elgin vineyards was harvested in 2010, which was a 5-barrel run under the Artisan range.

From the vineyard & cellar

Our grapes are harvested in the cool, early morning hours to retain their freshness and vibrant character. They are gently crushed and pressed to extract only the finest juice, which is then carefully clarified and transferred to stainless steel tanks for fermentation. Temperature control during fermentation ensures a slow, steady process, preserving the wine's bright fruit flavors and delicate aromatics. Once the wine reaches perfection, it is filtered, stabilized, and bottled, ready to enjoy.

In the bottle

On the palate, zesty notes of lemon and lime create a refreshing burst of citrus, complemented by subtle hints of green apple and the soft sweetness of stone fruits like peach and apricot. The wine finishes clean and crisp, with a lingering sensation that showcases its well-balanced acidity and pure elegance. This versatile wine is perfect as an aperitif or paired with light seafood dishes, fresh salads, or delicate appetizers, allowing its refreshing, vibrant character to shine with every sip..
